"TSC Early Voting Polling Site Changes in Brownsville"

Brownsville, TX- The Cameron County Elections Office announced the following Early Voting Sites location changes for the Texas Southmost College Runoff Election:

The Brownsville Public Library-Main Branch on Central Boulevard has moved to the New Horizon Medical Center, 191 E Price Rd, Brownsville, TX.

The Brownsville Public Library-Southmost Branch on Southmost Rd, has moved to Christ the King Catholic Church, 2255 Southmost Rd, Brownsville, TX.

Due to conflicts in the schedules at the Brownsville Public Libraries, they will not be available to serve as Early Voting Locations for the TSC runoff election.

Qualified voters will be able to cast their ballots during the early voting period of June 6th thru June 10th, and then again on June 13th and 14th from 9:00 am to 6:00 pm each day. In addition to the new sites, voters can go to any of the other sites which include the Old Election's Office at the Cameron County Judicial Complex, the County Annex in Los Fresnos, the Port Isabel City Hall and at Texas Southmost College.
