Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees

July 23, 2015

The Board of Trustees of the Texas Southmost College District convened in open session on July 23, 2015, at 5:30 p.m., in the Gorgas Board Room at Texas Southmost College. Board members present were Francisco G. Rendon, Chair; Ed Rivera, Secretary; Dr. Reynaldo García; Adela G. Garza; Ramon Champion Hinojosa; and Art Rendon. Also present was Dr. Lily F. Tercero, President of Texas Southmost College. Absent was Trey Mendez, Vice Chair.

Chairman Rendon called on Mr. Chet Lewis, Vice President of Finance and Administration, to present the item. Mr. Lewis gave an overview of the history of the security services on the campus. He stated that the Texas Procurement and Support Services Cooperative Purchasing Program (Purchasing CO-OP) is an available option for the use of the College in securing such services. He stated that four security companies are available, for the Board's consideration, to secure security services through a Purchasing CO-OP option.

A motion was made by Mr. Hinojosa to enter into contract negotiations with American Surveillance to provide Campus Security Services and to authorize the President to execute the contract. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Garza and carried unanimously. *Exhibit "B"*
